

## Medical Study in England

### Pre-Medical Foundation programme

\* Entry to this course is competitive and based on grades. A minimum 80% average (including similar grades or higher in mathematics) will be required. Good maths grades will be a distinct advantage for students during their foundation studies, and beyond.

\* Students progress from Pre-Medical Foundation to Pre-Med by achieving these progression rates in their Foundation year: 65% overall and a merit in English (approx 65%; which is an IELTS 6.5 equivalent). As long as they achieve these scores you will be guaranteed progression from Pre-Medical Foundation onto the Pre-Medical course.

### Pre-Medical course

\* Progressing from Pre-Med to Medical School is dependent on similar grades plus an interview. This will allow successful students to proceed either onto Bachelor of Medicine or Dentistry. Students must apply and for acceptance to Medical school will be subject to passing the interview as well as meeting the conditional entry requirements. The interview stage is normal for entry to UK Medical Schools. Therefore this part of the progression is not guaranteed. One of the strengths of this pathway is the number of progression options available to students in instances where they are not successful in securing a place at University. Students are provided with a number of other options, thus increasing their chances of gaining acceptance into medicine/dentistry. Some other Medical schools allow students to articulate if they meet the required progression grade only.
